## ART CHOICES

"THE LAST PARTY": Way too much of a good thing, this look at 20th century nightlife includes 261 pictures by everyone from Avedon and Arbus to Warhol and Winogrand with a vast amount of less-than-stellar material in between. Maybe this excess was intended to reflect the show's subject, but, with a salon-style hanging on two floors, it's easy to miss the great shots (like Ted Croner's Madison Square Garden horse show or David LaChapelle's foamfilled Ibizia club) and get lost in paparazzi dreck.
