A new exhibition of the designer's artwork, called 'Reiph Rucci Ascension,' has recently opened at San Francisco's <u>Bares Soroko Callen</u>.

On display are over 30 eye-catching acrylic and mixed-media works produced on canvas, with influences ranging from Abstract Expressionism to Japanese culture to the mysterious scrawls of Cy Twombly. The exhibition is on view through January 18 and includes enigmatic works that Rucch has created over the past two years, several of them bearing sweeping brushstrokes that are collaged, here and there, with scraps of silken fabrics.
